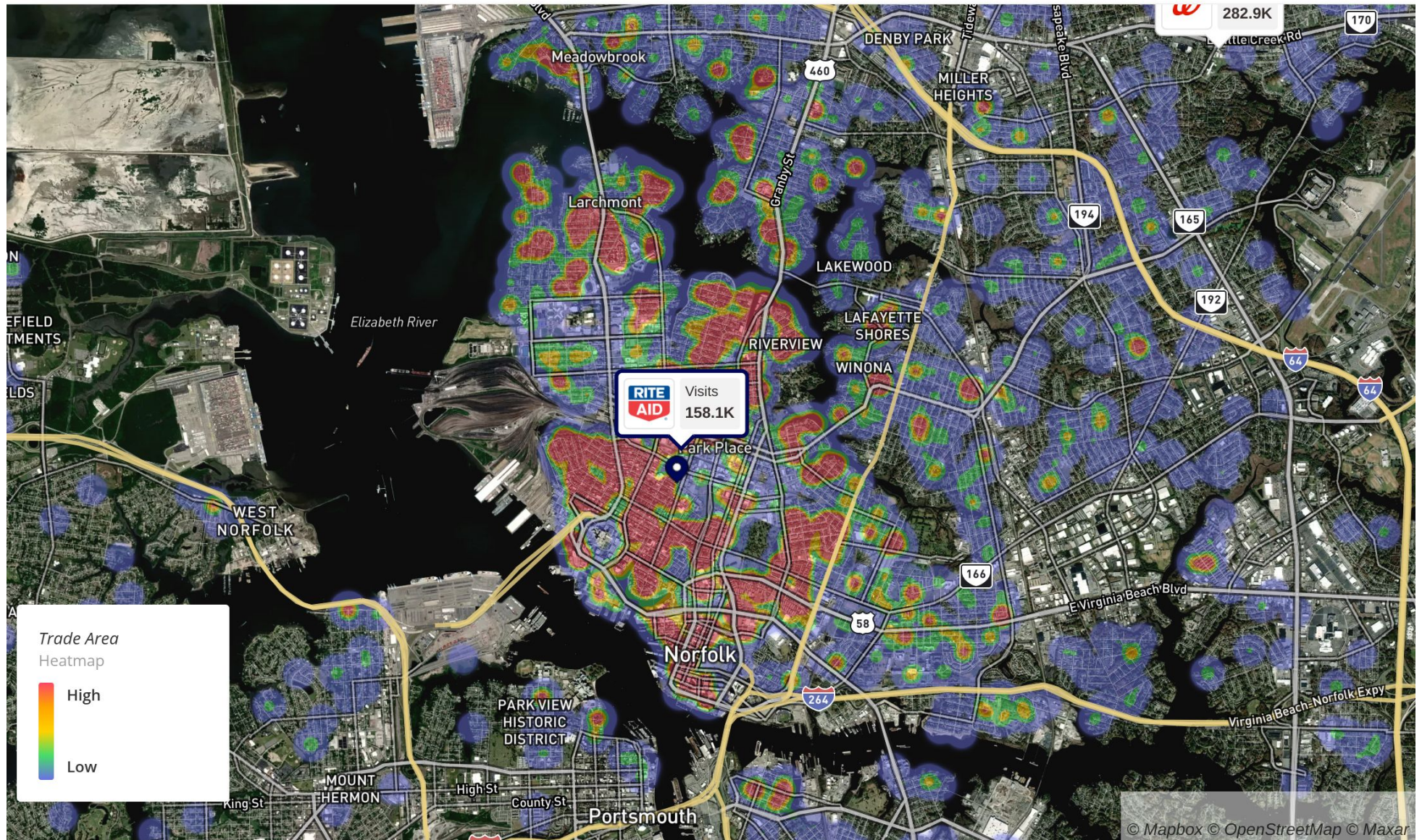

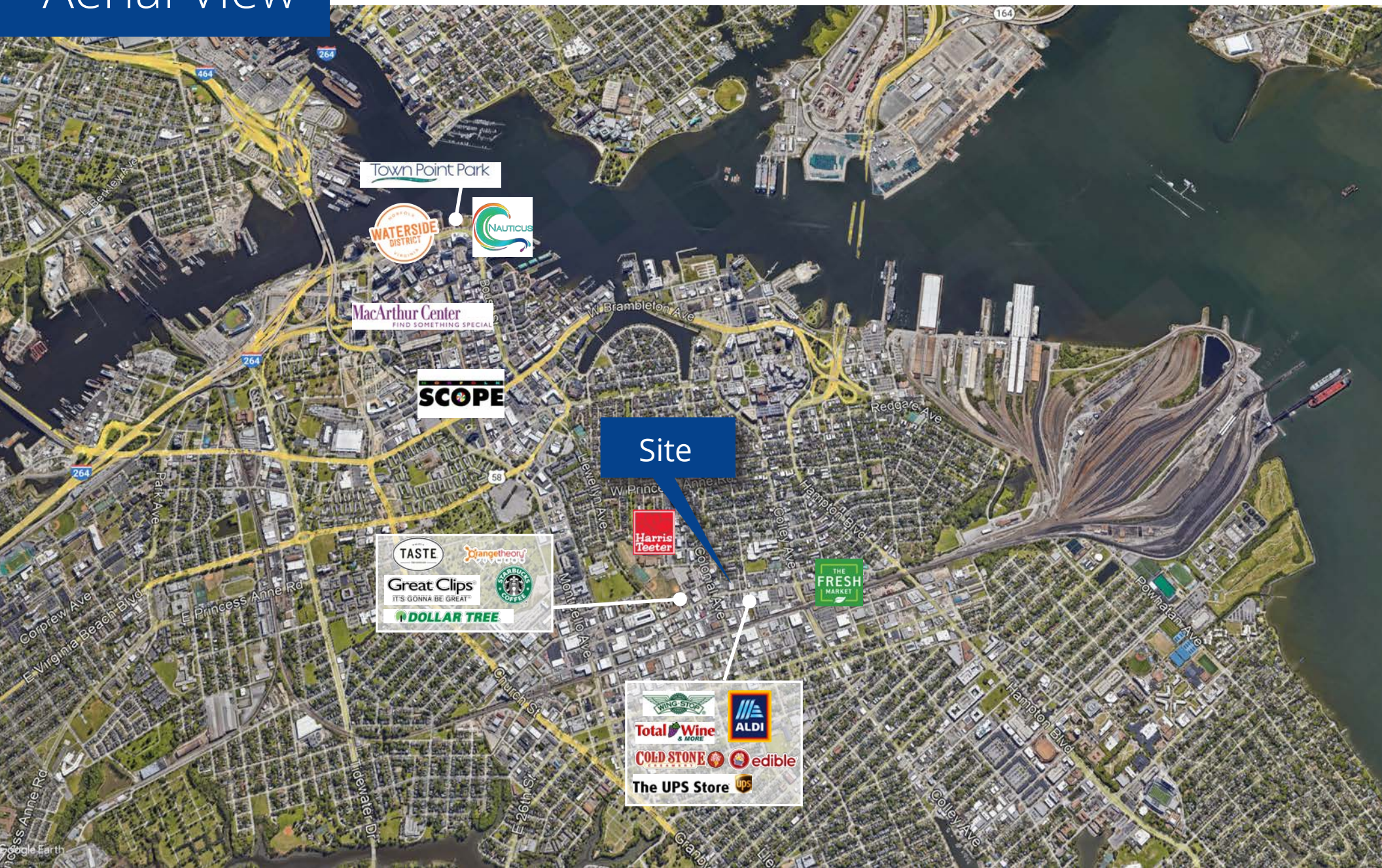

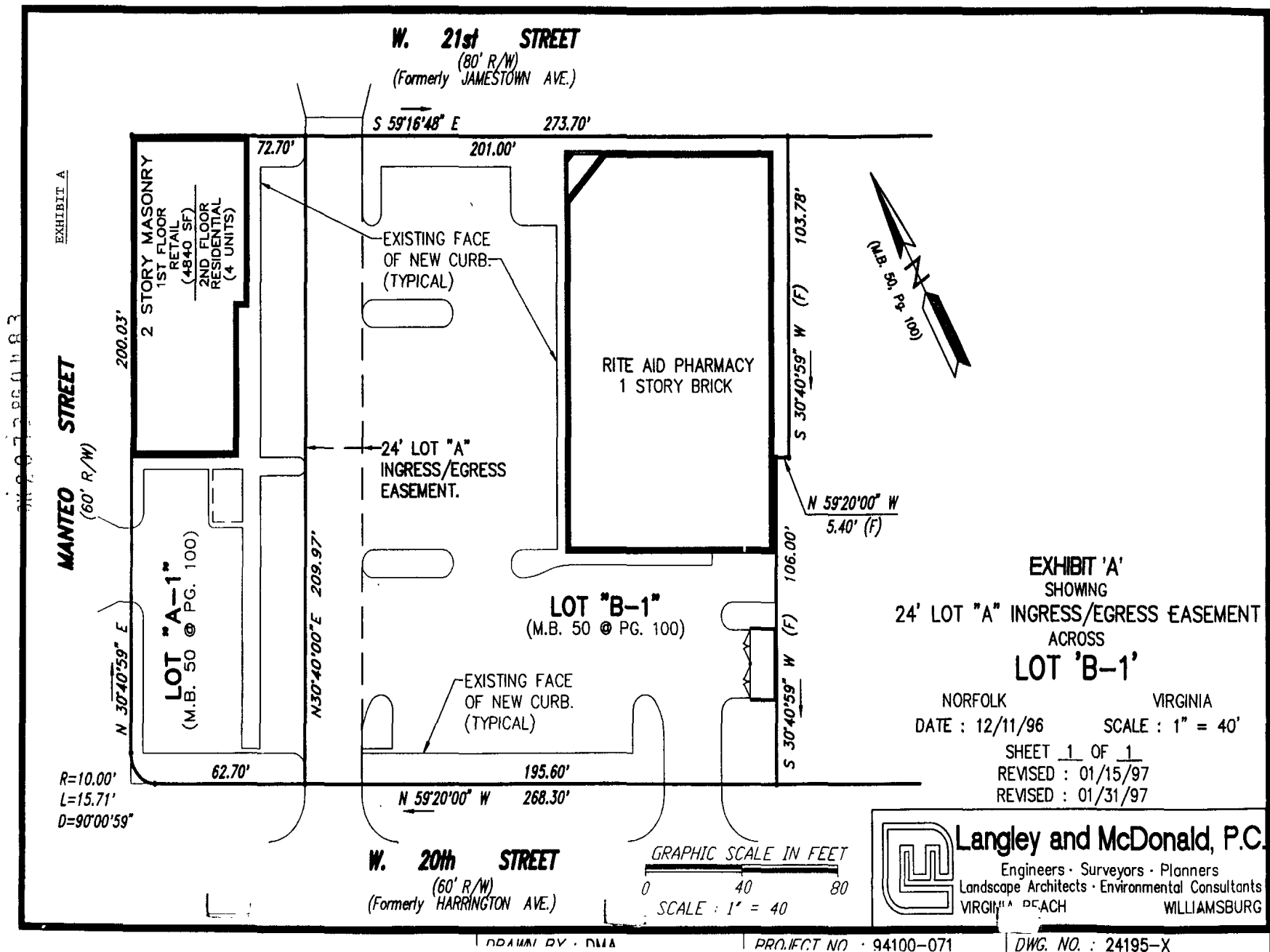
Market Landscape

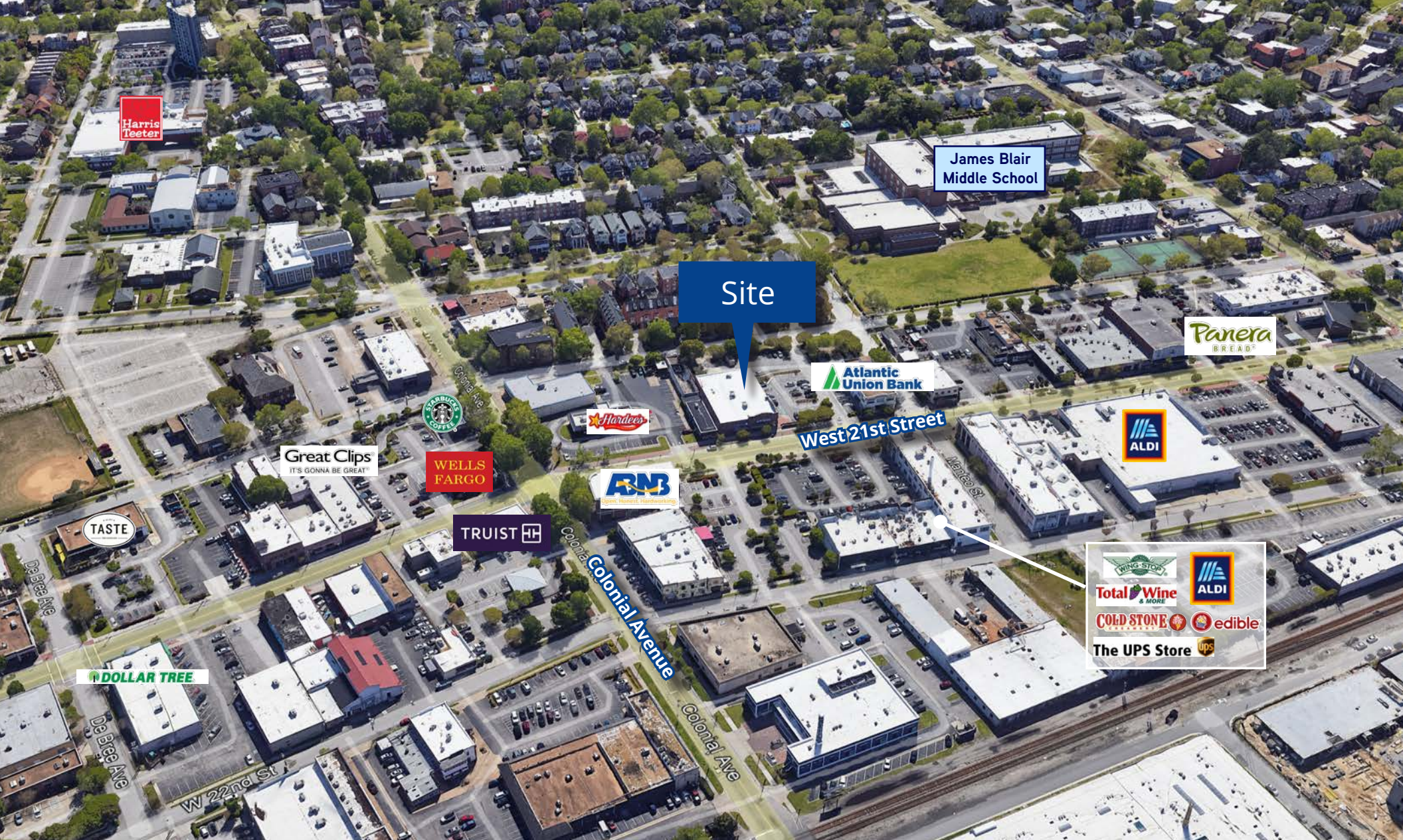
